Clement Hubbard, Be it remembered & it is hereby certified that the following Bill of sale was recorded on the 10th day of January A. D. 1851, to wit:

I know all men by their parents that I, Thomas Storr, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars, current money, to me in hand paid by Clement Hubbard, of Dorchester County State of Maryland, have granted, bargained and sold, and by their parents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Clement Hubbard, his heirs & assigns, Negro Woman Milley, aged about twenty years, slave for life and kind in body and mind. To have & to hold the said Negro Woman Milley aged as aforesaid and slave for life as aforesaid, as above bargained & sold, unto the said Clement Hubbard, his heirs, executors, Administrators & assigns, against me the said Thomas Storr, my heirs, executors and Administrators, and against all & every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant and forever defend. In testimony whereof I, Thomas Storr have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this eighth day of January in the year eighteen hundred and fifty one.
