Know all men by these presents that I, Susan Tubman, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars, current money, to me in hand paid by George Wallace, of the County & State aforesaid, at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Susan Tubman hath benjamin & sold, transferred and delivered, and by these presents doth benjamin & sell, transfer & deliver, unto the said George Wallace, his heirs and assigns forever, one Negro Man, named Joe, aged about forty five years, and a slave for life. To have and to hold the said Negro Man, named Joe, a slave for life, unto the said George Wallace, his heirs and assigns forever, against me the said Susan Tubman and my heirs, and against all persons whatsoever, to the only proper use of the said George Wallace, his heirs & assigns forever, and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Susan Tubman has hereunto subscribed her name and affixed her seal this 19th day of February in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.
