

Henry Collins, of the County & State aforesaid, at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, I, the said William Collins do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Henry Collins, his heirs, executors, Administrators and Assigns, all the goods, household stuff, implements and furniture and stock particularly mentioned, expressed & contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed, that is to say, one gray Mare about four years old, one Sorrel Horse twelve years old, one Yoke of Oxen, one Cart, seven head of Cattle, thirteen head of Sheep and thirteen head of Hogs, all & singular goods & Chattels & stock are now remaining in the occupation of the said William Collins: To have and to hold all & singular the goods, household stuff, implements, furniture & stock, above bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Henry Collins, his heirs, executors, Administrators & Assigns forever. And I, the said William Collins, for myself, my heirs, executors and Administrators, all and singular the said goods &c. unto the said Henry Collins, his executors, Administrators and Assigns, against me, the said William Collins, my executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant & forever defend by these presents; of all & singular which goods &c. I the said William Collins have put the said Henry Collins in full possession by delivering to him, the said Henry Collins, one Sorrel Horse at the sealing & delivery of these presents in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained & sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, unto him the said Henry Collins as aforesaid.
