 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Sarah
 B. Dunnock have granted, bargained & sold, and by these
 presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said John
 Brohawn, his Executors, Administrators & assigns my Negro
 James Kiss, aged about thirty years, a slave for life. To
 have and to hold the said Negro Man above bargained &
 sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said John Brohawn
 his Executors, Administrators or assigns, all & singular of which
 said Negro, I, the said Sarah B. Dunnock have put the said
 John Brohawn in full possession by delivering to him the said
 John Brohawn the said Negro hereby bargained & sold. In
 testimony whereof I, the said Sarah B. Dunnock, have hereunto
 set my hand & seal this 31st day of March 1857.
