 ents that we William ~~St. L.~~<sup>15<sup>th</sup> Mills, Washington A. Smith  
 and Juniah L. Patterson, of Dorchester County, are here and  
 jointly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full & just  
 sum of Three hundred dollars current money of the United  
 States, to be paid to the said State or its ~~court~~ Attorney,  
 to the which payment we will and truly to be made & done we  
 bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors and Administrators  
 in the whole and for the whole, jointly and severally,  
 jointly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and  
 dated this twenty first day of April 1851.</sup>

Whereas the Commissioners for Dorchester County, by virtue  
 of a supplement to the Act intitld an additional sup-  
 plement to the Act intitld an Act to regulate Ferries, be-  
 contracted with the said William H. Mills to keep the  
 Ferry over Fishing Creek from Minkins' neck to Hoopers  
 Island, and agree to allow the said William H. Mills  
 the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars, current money,  
 for the same. Now the condition of the above obli-  
 gation is such that if the above bounden William H. Mills  
 shall faithfully and diligently keep the said Ferry over  
 Fishing Creek from Minkins neck to Hoopers Island from  
 any light to day light from the first of November to the  
 first of March and from one hour before to an hour before  
 to an hour after day light for the six days of the year,  
 commenging the tenth day of May 1851 and ending twelve  
 months thereafter, and shall keep constantly and in good  
 order a boat that will safely carry three passengers and  
 two horses at one trip, with one able bodied helpe-  
 lar to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or  
 exact any greater price for ferries than what is allowed  
 him by law, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise  
 of full force and en tire in law.
