No. 100. Rachel M. of 1848

Be it remembered that the following Bill of Sale was recorded November 23. 1847, to wit:

Rachel M. } Know all men by these presents that I, Rachel  
 M. } M. of Dorchester County in the State of Mary-  
 land, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars,  
 current money, to me in hand paid by Caleb Hubbard of Dorchester  
 County and State of Maryland, at and before the sealing and  
 delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said Rachel  
 M. do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and  
 sold unto the said Caleb Hubbard, his Executors, Administrators  
 and Assigns one Negro Woman Eliza, one Girl Polly and one  
 Girl Child Margaret Ann, which said Negroes are now re-  
 maining in my possession, and now in the occupation of Doctor  
 Henry Gros - To have and to hold said Negroes above bargained  
 and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Caleb Hub-  
 bard, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever - And I,  
 the said Rachel M., for myself, my heirs, Executors and Ad-  
 ministrators, all and singular the said Negroes unto the said  
 Caleb Hubbard, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns,  
 against me the said Rachel M., my Executors Admini-  
 strators and against all and every other person or persons what-  
 soever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by their pre-  
 sents, of all and singular the said Negroes, and I the said Rachel  
 M. will put the said Caleb Hubbard in full possession  
 by delivering to him the said Caleb Hubbard all and singular  
 the said Negroes above named on the first day of January  
 next. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
 seal this twentieth day of November in the year of Our Lord  
 eighteen hundred & forty seven.
