Be it remembered that the following Bond was made on the 18th day of June 1857, to wit: Know all men by these presents that we John Richardson, John Tubman

and Samuel R. Durnock, of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Seven hundred and thirty four dollars and sixty five cents, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain Attorney, to which payment well & truly to be made & done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this Eighteenth day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden John Richardson, appointed Collector of Dorchester County, shall faithfully collect and pay the sum of Three hundred & sixty seven dollars and thirty three cents, current money of the United States, into the Treasury of the State of Maryland on or before the first day of July Eighteen hundred and fifty two, to ~~the~~ for the use of the State, then the above Obligation to be void, or else to be & remain in full force and virtue in Law.
