of Dorchester County, and State of Maryland, for and
in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States, in
hand paid by George Cooper at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged: I have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents
do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said George Cooper his Executors, Administrators and
Assigns, my negro woman named Dianna Cooper age about thirty one years,
to have and to hold, the said described negro woman Dianna Cooper to the said
George Cooper, and to the said Jeremiah L. Patterson his Executors, Administrators and Assigns
forever, and I the said Jeremiah L. Patterson, for myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators,
the said negro woman Dianna Cooper, unto the said George Cooper his Executors Administrators
and Assigns against me the said Jeremiah L. Patterson my executor and Administrators, and
against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever
defend by these presents. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 22nd day of August Eighteen hundred and fifty one.
