Ex. from } was recorded on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1847. To wit:  
Levin Phillips } I know all men by their persons that I, Levin Phillips, Executor of Margaret Phillips, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William R. Tall, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said William R. Tall, my Negro woman named Hannah to serve three years from the death of Margaret Phillips - also child William Erwin aged two years next March to serve until he is thirty one years old - To have and to hold the said Negroes, as above bargained and sold, unto the said William R. Tall, his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, against me the said Levin Phillips, Executor of Margaret Phillips, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons, shall and will warrant & defend. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty ninth day of November 1847.
