of sale was recorded on the 15th day of
September A.D. 1851, to wit:

I know all men by these presents that I
Michael Mitchell of Dorchester County & State of Maryland, for and
in consideration of the sum of Fifty five dollars, current Money
of Maryland, to me in hand paid by Samuel McBride of the
County and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained & sold,
and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the
said Samuel McBride, his heirs & assigns, one Negro slave
Called Affa, to serve until she is thirty years of age, which
will be the twenty third day of December eighteen hundred
and fifty four, at which time said Negro Woman will be
free. To have and to hold the said Negro Woman Affa,
as above bargained & sold, unto the said Samuel McBride,
his heirs, executors & administrators and assigns, against me
the said Michael Mitchell, my heirs, executors and administrators,
and against all persons whatsoever that & will warrant and
defend. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our names
and affixed our seals this fifteenth day of September eighteen
hundred & fifty one.
