Hubbard administrator of Henry Hubbard of Worcester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and dollars current money to me in hand paid by Deresa Hubbard of Worcester County and State of Maryland, I have granted, bargained, sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, & sell, unto the said Deresa Hubbard her heirs and assigns, the following Negro Woman Maria aged about twenty five years, slave for life, and bound in body and mind, to have and to hold the said negro woman Maria aged about twenty five years, as above bargained and sold unto the said Deresa Hubbard her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, against me the said Nenny P. Hubbard administrator of Henry Hubbard, my heirs, executors, and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend. In testimony whereof, I Nenny P. Hubbard have hereunto set my hand and official seal this day of November eighteen hundred and fifty one
