whom it may concern, be it known that I Mary S. Sullivan, of the
Town of Cambridge, in the County and State aforesaid, for divers good
causes and considerations, me therunto moving, have released from
Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do
hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my Negro
Man named Levin Camper, being of the age of forty four years,
and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood & maintenance
and him the said Negro Man named Levin Camper I do declare
to be hereforth free, manumitted & discharged from all manner
of service or servitude to me, my Executors or Administrators forever.
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name, and my seal
affixed this Eleventh day of December 1847.

acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these pre-
