Know all men by these presents that I  
Robert Stanley of Dochester County and State of Maryland for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of four hundred dollars current money of Mary-  
land to me in hand paid by Purpue Wright of the same County and State  
of record the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged here granted, barg-  
ained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the  
said Purpue Wright the following property to wit: Crop of Corn on the  
Farm at present occupied by me. All the Hubs fadon and top fadon, 60  
Bushels of Wheat more or less 30 heads of Hay more or less 1 yoke of Oxen  
& cows 3 quarter y head of Sheep 2 Beds Bedsteads & furniture 1 wooden  
Clock 1 Linnin Captom and contents, 2 pair Tables & 100 stool Chairs 1  
Loom and contents & Chenoweth Ploughs 2 Hoss Haulows 2 Cutting Axes 3  
Grabbing Hoss 1 Bay Horse 1 1/4 Cart 1 stool Chest, Stools & pine Chests 2  
scythes & blades 9 head of geese 5 Turkeys 100 head of Chickens more or less  
I have and to hold, the said goods and chattels as above bargained and sold,  
unto the said Purpue Wright his heirs executors administrators and  
assigns against one the said Robert Stanley my heirs executors and ad-  
ministrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever  
shall and will warrant and firm defend. In Testimony whereof I  
have hereto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of  
November Eighteen hundred and fifty one.
