


These presents, does give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said John S Staplefort his heirs and assigns Negro man Sam Do har and to hold the said Negro man Sam unto the said John S Staplefort his heirs and assigns forever, provided all ways, and it is the true intent and meaning of these presents and of the parties here unto, That if the said Samuel Burns shall will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John S Staplefort the sum of two hundred and forty dollars and Eighty four cents with legal interest from the Eighth of October 1851. In six Months from the date of these presents, then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein containing to the contrary notwithstanding.
