Provided always, and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents, that if the said Isaac Bailey shall fail and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Virian W. Woolford, his Executors administrators and assigns the full sum of Thirty three dollars and thirty five cents, current money, with legal interest for the same on or before the twenty fifth day of December eighteen hundred and fifty five. Then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall cease to determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes, any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. And the said Isaac Bailey for himself his Executors administrators and assigns, and for every of them doth earnestly promise and agree, to act with the said Virian W. Woolford his Executors administrators and assigns by these presents in manner and form following. That the said Isaac Bailey his Executors administrators shall fail and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Virian W. Woolford his Executors administrators and assigns the said sum of Thirtv One dollars, and twenty five cent current money together with interest for the same after the above and fore said at such time and often such manner as herein before agreed and agreed for the payment thereof.
