Current money to me in hand paid by Jurpin Wright of same County and State  
at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the  
said Mark H. Marshall do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Jurpin Wright his  
executors administrators and assigns all the following property to wit 1 Horse called  
Charley 1 Mare called Jolley 2 Cows 2 Yearlings 1 Calf 1 Ox Cart 1 Plough  
2 Harrows 2 Sows & 11 Shoats 7 old Sheep & 6 lambs 10 Barrells Corn more or less 1 Stack  
blade Fodder Crop Wheat on the Ground Crop Potatoes on ground 5 Beds Bedsteads  
& Furniture 1 Cupboard and contents 2 tables & 3 chairs & 3 Chests all the said property  
Goods or Chattels are now in possession of the said Mark H. Marshall tenant to  
Jurpin Wright. To have and to hold all and singular the said property goods  
and Chattels and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and  
intended so to be to the said Jurpin Wright his executors administrators and assigns
