Know all men by these presents that I Susan Tubman of Dorchester County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty Dollars Current Money of Maryland to me in hand paid by George Hart of the said County and State before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Susan Tubman has granted bargained sold conveyed and transferred and by these presents does grant bargain sell convey and transfer unto the said George Hart his heirs and assigns the following negro to wit One Negro woman named Maria aged about Seventeen years of a dark Chestnut or Black Colour and about 5 feet high with a scar on her left side & black occasioned by a burn from fire Slave for life To have and to hold the said above named Negro unto the said George Hart his heirs and assigns forever to his and their sole use and uses forever and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever against me the said Susan Tubman and my heirs and against all persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof the said Susan Tubman has hereunto subscribed her name and affixed her seal the 6th Day of May 1852
