Hooks of Dorchester County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars Current money to me in hand paid by Levin Busick of York County in the State of Virginia at or before the sealing and delivering and delivering of these the receipt whereof I the said Levin S. Hooks do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Levin Busick his executors administrators and assigns the following property To wit Crop of wheat on the ground one brace Cow one sow and eight pigs two Beds bedsteads and furniture two Carpets three tables twelve Chairs one water stand, two wash stands two Toilette Tables two looking Glasses one Clock eight pieces of Cooking implements Six pieces wooden ware One dozen knives and forks three barrels of Corn one wheelbarrow and all the balance of my household and kitchen furniture twenty cords of woodcut in the woods To have and to hold all and singular the said goods household stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be to the said Levin Busick his executors administrators and assigns forever In witness whereof I the said Levin S. Hooks have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 26th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty two
