Pattison of the same County and State at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Leecompt do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John R. Pattison his executors administrators and assigns One negro man named Robert Jackson of a dark Chesnut color and a slave for life aged about thirty eight or thirty nine years To have and to hold the said negro man slave Robert Jackson above bargained and sold to the said John R. Pattison his executors administrators and assigns against me the said Peter G. Leecompt my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seal this Sixth Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two
