four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Edmund North, have
granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain
and sell, unto the said Edmund North, my Negro Man named Jenkins,
aged about twenty five years, servant for about fourteen years,
according to Bill of sale of Tho. J. Patterson, and found in body ~~and~~
mind - To have and to hold the said Negro man Jenkins for his
term of service according to Bill of sale executed to me the past
year from Thomas J. Patterson, as above bargained and sold, unto
the said Edmund North, his heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns, against me the said John E. Stevens, my heirs, executors and
administrators, and against all and every other person or persons shall
and will warrant and defend. In testimony whereof I have here to
set my hand and affix my seal this fourth day of January 1848.
