consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred and ten dollars, to me in hand paid by Joniah Carroll, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Joniah Carroll, my Negroes hereinafter named, that is to say, Negro Man Charles, aged thirty six years, Negro Woman Dinah aged thirty four years, Negro Woman Nutter aged thirty five years, Negro Boy Jeremiah aged thirteen years, Negro Boy Mitchell aged eleven years, Negro Boy William aged nine years, Negro Girl Catharine aged seven years, Negro Boy Milton aged six years, Negro Boy George M. Dallas aged three years, and Negro Infant Girl Mary Elizabeth aged one year; all of the aforesaid Negroes slaves for life and found in body & mind. To have and to hold the said Negro Man Charles, Negro Woman Dinah, Negro Woman Nutter, Negro Boy Jeremiah, Negro Boy Mitchell, Negro Boy William, Negro Girl Catharine, Negro Boy Milton, Negro Boy George M. Dallas, and Negro Infant Girl Mary Elizabeth as above bargained and sold, unto the said Joniah Carroll, his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, against me the said Elizabeth H. Roberson, administrator of John Roberson, deceased, my heirs, executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons, shall and will warrant and defend.
