said Negro slave, agreeably to the Act of Assembly in such case made and

On the 20th day of January 1848, the above named Henry D. Wright, Guardian

said John H. Harris, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, one
Sordid Gelding, bought at the sale of the personal Estate of G. W. Noble,
one four Mare, bought at the City of Baltimore, one dark bay Mare,
bought from B. Tomlinson, and one lean four Mare, called Lisa, one
Mail Coach and four sets of Harness now used with her; all the afo^r prop-
erty is now in my possession. To have and to hold the said property
aforesaid, to the said John H. Harris, his Executors, Administrators and
Assigns forever: and I, the said William J. Benjamin, for myself, my
heirs, executors and Administrators, the aforesaid Harris, Heirs & Assigns
