 65. from } Sale was recorded on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1848.  
 Garrison Bright } Know all men by these presents I Garrison Bright  
 of Douchester County in the State of Maryland for  
 and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars current money to  
 me in hand paid by Levin W. Tall of the County and State aforesaid said  
 at and before the filing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof  
 I the said Garrison Bright do hereby acknowledge and by these presents  
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said Levin W. Tall all of the fol-  
 lowing property, to wit one dark bay Mare one red Horse one red Cow  
 one old dead red Cow one young red Stear yearling one dark brindle one  
 red bull yearling one dark brindle yearling Bull one pink Bull yearling  
 one black Stear with white face one black Stear one Cart seven head of  
 Sheep sixteen head of hogs one Fodder house and twelve barrels of Corn  
 and two thirds of Crop of wheat sowed on the ground" to have & to hold  
 all of said property unto the said Levin W. Tall his heirs and assigns  
 forever free and clear of all incumbrances from me the said Garrison  
 Bright my heirs and assigns forever or any other person claiming of  
 the same either at Law or Equity" in Witness whereof the said  
 Garrison Bright hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal  
 the Eight day of February in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred  
 and forty eight
