whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained & sold, and
by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Henry Hubbard,
his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, one Negro Boy named
Henry, yellow complexion, age about nineteen years, to serve until
the first day of May Eighteen hundred and fifty four when the
said Boy Henry is to be free: To have and to hold the said de-
scribed yellow Boy Henry until the first day of May Eighteen hundred
and fifty four, to the said Henry Hubbard, his Executors, Administrators
and Assigns: And I the said John Mauldin for myself, my heirs,
executors and Administrators, the said yellow Boy Henry, unto the
said Henry Hubbard, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, against
me the said John Mauldin, my Executors and Administrators, and
against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will
warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have
