 said Thomas C. Jones and John Jones of Col. Executors of Col. John
 Jones de^d, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred &
 fifty dollars, current money, to them in hand paid by the said Alex-
 ander Woolford, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained
 and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell unto the
 said Alexander Woolford, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns,
 one Negro Man named Isaac belonging to the estate of the aforesaid
 Col. John Jones de^d, for the full term of four years from the first
 day of this present month March, at the expiration of the time of
 servitude above mentioned the said Negro Isaac to be free. To have
 and to hold the said Negro Man Isaac unto the said Alexander
 Woolford, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to his & their own
 use and benefit during the said time or term above mentioned and no
 longer - Now the said parties fully agree to all the matters & conditions
 set forth in this bill of sale, or instrument of writing. In
 Witness whereof the said Thomas C. Jones and John Jones of Col.
 Executors as aforesaid, and Alexander Woolford aforesaid, have
 hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first herein
 before written.
