- (11) CONDUCTING ANY OTHER BUSINESS ACTIVITY THAT IS REASONABLY ANCILLARY TO AN INSURANCE BUSINESS; OR
- (12) OWNING ONE OR MORE CORPORATIONS ENGAGED EXCLUSIVELY IN OR ORGANIZED TO ENGAGE EXCLUSIVELY IN ONE OR MORE OF THE BUSINESS ACTIVITIES SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 48A, § 493(a).

In the introductory language of this section, the reference to investments allowed "elsewhere in this article" is added for clarity and to conform to the similar reference in § 7-202(a) of this subtitle, which revises the introductory language of former Art. 48A, § 493(b).

Also in the introductory language of this section, the phrase "business activities that are ancillary to an insurance business" is substituted for the former phrase "ancillary businesses" for clarity and to conform to item (11) of this section.
