- (1) A PERSON THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE COURTS OF THE STATE UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS DEEMED TO APPOINT THE COMMISSIONER AS ATTORNEY FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS IN ANY PROCEEDING ARISING OUT OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.
 - (2) COPIES OF ALL PROCESS SHALL BE SERVED ON THE COMMISSIONER.
- (3) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL SEND A COPY OF THE PROCESS BY REGISTERED MAIL TO THE PERSON AT THE PERSON'S LAST KNOWN ADDRESS.

7–309. FAILURE TO FILE STATEMENT OR MAKING UNAUTHORIZED ACQUISITION.

A PERSON VIOLATES THIS TITLE IF:

- (1) THE PERSON FAILS TO FILE THE STATEMENT REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE; OR
- (2) THE PERSON, WITHOUT THE COMMISSIONER'S APPROVAL DURING THE 60-DAY PERIOD UNDER § 7-306(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, OR AFTER THE COMMISSIONER'S DISAPPROVAL, MAKES OR ATTEMPTS TO MAKE AN ACQUISITION OF ACTUAL OR PRESUMED CONTROL OF OR A MERGER WITH A DOMESTIC INSURER OR INSURANCE HOLDING COMPANY CONTROLLING A DOMESTIC INSURER.
