(C) FRATERNAL BENEFIT AGENT.

"FRATERNAL BENEFIT AGENT" MEANS AN AUTHORIZED OR ACKNOWLEDGED AGENT OF A SOCIETY THAT ACTS AS AN AGENT IN SOLICITING, NEGOTIATING, PROCURING, OR MAKING LIFE INSURANCE, HEALTH INSURANCE, OR ANNUITY CONTRACTS.

8-402. SOCIETY DEEMED FRATERNAL BENEFIT SOCIETY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

- (1) AN INCORPORATED SOCIETY, ORDER, OR SUPREME LODGE WITHOUT CAPITAL STOCK IS DEEMED TO BE A FRATERNAL BENEFIT SOCIETY IF IT:
- (I) IS CONDUCTED SOLELY FOR THE BENEFIT OF ITS MEMBERS AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES;
 - (II) IS NOT CONDUCTED FOR PROFIT;
- (III) IS OPERATED ON A LODGE SYSTEM WITH RITUALISTIC FORM OF WORK;
 - (IV) HAS A REPRESENTATIVE FORM OF GOVERNMENT, AND
