8-450. APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATES OF QUALIFICATION.

AN APPLICANT FOR A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION SHALL:

(1) FILE WITH THE COMMISSIONER AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER PROVIDES; AND

(2) PAY TO THE COMMISSIONER A BIENNIAL FEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 48A, § 344E(2) and, as it related to a biennial fee, (1).

In item (1) of this section, the former reference to a "written" application "and supplements thereto" "containing such information, as the Commissioner may require" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to "an application on the form that the Commissioner provides".

8-451. EXAMINATIONS.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON THAT WAS LICENSED OR QUALIFIED AS A FRATERNAL BENEFIT AGENT IN THE STATE BEFORE JULY 1, 1985.

(B) REQUIRED.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION TO PASS A WRITTEN EXAMINATION.

(C) CONTENTS.

THE EXAMINATION SHALL INCLUDE QUESTIONS ONLY ABOUT:

(1) INSURANCE ISSUED BY SOCIETIES;

(2) THE TYPES OF CERTIFICATES, POLICIES, OR CONTRACTS IN GENERAL PROPOSED TO BE SOLICITED UNDER THE CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION; AND
