10-302. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

The former phrase "under the requirements" of Article 27, § 616 1/2(f) is deleted as surplusage.

10-303. REGULATIONS.

10-304. LICENSE REQUIRED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN INDIVIDUAL MUST OBTAIN A LICENSE BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL PROVIDES BAIL BONDSMAN SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(B) SAME AS CERTIFICATE OF OUALIFICATION.

A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS IDENTICAL TO A CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION ISSUED UNDER SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS TITLE.
