(11) Preliminary discussion concerning purchase or disposition of real property.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.

CHAPTER 78

(House Bill 664)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Smith Island - Solid Waste District

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to designate the part of Smith Island in Somerset County as a solid waste district for the purpose of imposing on improved property a certain fee relating to solid waste removal; limiting the amount of the fee; providing that the fee shall be compatible to certain costs incurred by other property owners in the County; specifying certain procedures relating to the administration and collection of the fee; providing that the fee constitutes a lien on the property and may be collected in the same manner as property taxes may be collected; providing that a fee not paid by a certain date is subject to certain interest charges; and generally relating to authorization for a certain fee on developed property on Smith Island for solid waste removal.
