CHAPTER 83

(House Bill 806)

AN ACT concerning

Interagency Committee on Aging Services – Membership

FOR the purpose of expanding the membership of the State Interagency Committee on Aging Services by adding the Director of the Governor’s Office for Individuals with Disabilities; and generally relating to the composition of the Interagency Committee on Aging Services.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 70B – Office on Aging

Section 4B(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1988 Replacement Volume and 1994 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 70B – Office on Aging

4B.

(a) The Interagency Committee on Aging Services consists of the following members:

- (1) The Director of the Office on Aging;
- (2) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (3) The Secretary of Human Resources;
- (4) The Secretary of Transportation;
- (5) The Secretary of Housing and Community Development;
- (6) The Secretary of Economic and Employment Development;

(7) THE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES;

[(7)](8) A representative from a local area agency on aging to be appointed by the Governor from a list submitted by the Maryland Association of Area Agencies on Aging; and

[(8)](9) A member of the general public to be appointed by the Governor.
