- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a project may not be undertaken by the [District] COUNTY without the consent of the owner of each property to be served
 - (b) This section applies to:
- (1) Projects which would result in the addition of three or more water or sewerage services;
- (2) Actions which would result in the elimination of three or more water or sewerage services; and
- (3) The reduction or elimination of a reserved area within a subdistrict, which would result in the addition of three or more water or sewerage services.
- (c) (1) The county [and the Commission] may propose a project by [joint] resolution.
- (2) A resolution shall set forth the nature of the project and the locations at which service would be provided or eliminated.
- (d) After the adoption of a [joint] resolution proposing a project, the [Commission] COUNTY shall have preliminary plats, plans, and financial estimates prepared.
- (e) (1) The [Commission] COUNTY shall schedule a hearing on a proposed project after the completion of the preliminary plats, plans, and financial estimates.
- (2) The [Commission] COUNTY shall publish a notice for two weeks in at least one newspaper published in the county.
- (3) The notice shall state that the plat and plans of each project may be inspected at the office of the [Commission] COUNTY during regular business hours, the date of the hearing, the time of the hearing, the place of the hearing, and that any interested person may testify at the hearing.
- (f) (1) At the hearing the [Commission] COUNTY shall present the preliminary plats, plans, and financial estimates.
 - (2) All interested persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard.
- (g) For 10 days following the hearing, the [Commission] COUNTY shall receive written comments and petitions from interested persons.
- (h) (1) Not less than 10 days following the hearing, the [Commission] COUNTY shall meet to consider the statements made at the hearing and the written comments and petitions received.
- (2) By resolution the [Commission] COUNTY shall adopt, with or without amendment, or reject the proposed plats and plans for the project.
