AN ACT concerning

**Security Systems Technicians - ~~Exception from Licensure Requirements~~ Licensure Deadlines and Sunset Extension**

FOR the purpose of ~~excepting persons licensed under the Maryland Home Improvement Law from licensure requirements for security systems technicians; requiring persons licensed under the Maryland Home Improvement Law to perform certain acts prior to engaging in the business of providing securities systems services extending the time by which a person who is engaged in the business of providing security system services is required to obtain a license; extending the termination date of a certain Act; providing that this Act is an emergency measure; and generally relating to the licensure of security systems technicians.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
