- (1) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS OF THE FORVM; AND
- (2) ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE FORVM OR BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.
- (C) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE FORVM. 15–107.
- (A) THE FORVM IS AN INDEPENDENT UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT AND MAY NOT BE PLACED BY THE GOVERNOR IN ANY PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT.
  - (B) THE FORVM IS EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF:
    - (1) DIVISION I OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE;
- (2) DIVISION II OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN § 11–203(B) OF THAT ARTICLE; AND
  - (3) TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- (C) (1) THE FORVM SHALL RECEIVE ANNUAL FUNDING THROUGH AN APPROPRIATION IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT SHALL INCLUDE WITHOUT REVISION THE BUDGET REQUEST OF THE FORVM WITH THE BUDGET REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT.
- (D) THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE FORVM WITH NECESSARY STAFF AND RESOURCES, INCLUDING OFFICE SPACE IF DESIRED BY THE FORVM.
- (E) EACH UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE DELIBERATIONS OF THE FORVM AND WORK WITH THE FORVM ON MATTERS RELATING TO THE UNIT.
- (F) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL SERVE AS LEGAL ADVISOR TO THE FORVM.

## THE FORVM MAY:

- (1) MAINTAIN AN OFFICE AT A LOCATION THAT THE FORVM DESIGNATES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORVM BUDGET;
- (2) EMPLOY, AS REGULAR EMPLOYEES OR AS INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS, STAFF THAT THE FORVM CONSIDERS NECESSARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORVM BUDGET;
  - (3) ENTER INTO CONTRACTS;
