

(4) ACCEPT GRANTS;

(5) ACCEPT ASSISTANCE OF ANY KIND FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OTHER UNITS OF STATE GOVERNMENT, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, OR FROM ANY PRIVATE SOURCES; AND

(6) DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT TO CARRY OUT ITS PURPOSE.

15-109.

(A) THE FORVM SHALL PUBLISH AN ANNUAL REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE FORVM.

(B) THE REPORT SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

15-110.

(A) (1) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES IF THE FORVM IS DISSOLVED.

(2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE DISPOSITION OF ANY FUNDS OR OTHER ASSETS OF THE STATE.

(B) AFTER PAYING OR MAKING PROVISION FOR THE PAYMENT OF ANY LIABILITY OF THE FORVM, THE FORVM SHALL DISPOSE OF ALL ASSETS OF THE FORVM IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE PURPOSES OF THE FORVM BY TRANSFERRING THE ASSETS TO AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS ORGANIZED AND OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL, RELIGIOUS, OR SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES AND THAT IS THEN QUALIFIED AS AN EXEMPT ORGANIZATION UNDER § 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

(C) IF THE FORVM FAILS TO DISPOSE OF ANY ASSETS, THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE FORVM HAS ITS PRINCIPAL OFFICE SHALL DISPOSE OF THE ASSETS IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

Article - State Finance and Procurement

11-203.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does not apply to:

(1) procurement by:

(i) the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland;

(ii) the Maryland State Arts Council, for the support of the arts;

(iii) the Maryland Health and Higher Educational Facilities Authority.

if no State money is to be spent on a procurement contract;
