- (2) To provide not more than \$2,000,000 in grants to provide assistance to grant and loan recipients to meet the local share of construction costs; <u>and</u>
- (3) To provide not more than \$1,250,000 in grants for water quality clean-up activities in small creeks and estuaries, provided that funds may not be expended for feasibility studies.
- (4) To provide not more than \$3,500,000 in grants for projects to control agriculturally related nonpoint sources of pollution...
