(b) Notwithstanding the placement of a unit in a principal department:

(2) a State officer or State employee who is not in the classified service of the State Personnel Management System and is transferred with the unit remains exempt from the provisions of the State Personnel AND PENSIONS Article that govern classified service employees and the regulations adopted under those provisions unless the officer or the employee is placed in the classified service in accordance with those provisions; and
