(L) CHESAPEAKE BAY WATER QUALITY PROJECT FUNDS

(1) To be credited to the Water Pollution Control Fund to be expended for projects to improve the water quality of the Chesapeake Bay and other waters of the State, as authorized under Title 9, Subtitle 3, Part VI of the Environment Article, as follows:

- (a) To provide not more than \$1,355,000 in grants to assist in the construction of publicly owned sewage treatment works;
- (b) Not more than \$4,645,000 to provide grants for projects to remove nutrients at publicly owned sewage treatment works;
- (c) Not more than [~~\$1,300,000~~] \$2,550,000 to provide grants for nonpoint source pollution control retrofit projects in existing urban areas;
- (d) Not more than \$800,000 to provide grants for water quality clean-up activities in creeks and small estuaries;
- (e) Not more than \$4,917,000 to provide grants to provide assistance to grant and loan recipients to meet the local share of construction costs;
- (f) Not more than [~~\$3,000,000~~] ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$4,600,000 to provide grants for projects to control agriculturally related nonpoint sources of pollution
