CHAPTER 145

(Senate Bill 132)

AN ACT concerning

Uniform Laws Commission - Life Members

FOR the purpose of specifying that an individual elected to life membership in the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, after service as an appointed member of the State Commission on Uniform State Laws, shall be an ex officio member of the State Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-203.

- (a) The Commission consists of:
 - (1) 3 members appointed by the Governor; AND
- (2) AS AN EX OFFICIO MEMBER, ANY INDIVIDUAL ELECTED TO LIFE MEMBERSHIP IN THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF COMMISSIONERS ON UNIFORM STATE LAWS, AFTER SERVICE AS AN APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION FROM THIS STATE.
- (b) (1) The term of [a] AN APPOINTED member is 4 years and begins on June 1 of the year in which the term of the Governor begins.
- (2) At the end of a term, [a] AN APPOINTED member continues to serve until a successor is appointed.
- (3) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1995.
