SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 88A - Social Services Administration

CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
 - (2) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
 - (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.
- (4) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS AND POLICIES TO ESTABLISH A CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.
- (C) ALL EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF THE STATE SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE REGULATIONS AND POLICIES OF THE PROGRAM.
 - (D) THE PURPOSES OF THE PROGRAM ARE:
- (1) TO ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS TO BECOME NATURALIZED CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES AND ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN THE CIVIC LIFE OF MARYLAND:
- (2) TO INCREASE THE NUMBER AND PROPORTION OF ELIGIBLE FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENTS WHO BECOME CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES; AND
- (3) TO ENCOURAGE FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENTS WHO BECOME CITIZENS TO BE INVOLVED IN OUR DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS.
- (E) (1) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL MAY SECURE FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM FROM THE STATE BUDGET.
- (2) <u>FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED \$100,000 OF THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.</u>
- (2) FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED \$100,000 OF THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.
 - (F) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, THE PROGRAM SHALL:
 - (1) ENCOURAGE ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS TO LEARN ENGLISH:
