

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 88A - Social Services Administration**

**CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.**

(A) (1) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.

(3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.

(4) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS AND POLICIES TO ESTABLISH A CITIZENSHIP PROMOTION PROGRAM.

(C) ALL EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES OF THE STATE SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE REGULATIONS AND POLICIES OF THE PROGRAM.

(D) THE PURPOSES OF THE PROGRAM ARE:

(1) TO ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS TO BECOME NATURALIZED CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES AND ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN THE CIVIC LIFE OF MARYLAND;

(2) TO INCREASE THE NUMBER AND PROPORTION OF ELIGIBLE FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENTS WHO BECOME CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES; AND

(3) TO ENCOURAGE FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENTS WHO BECOME CITIZENS TO BE INVOLVED IN OUR DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS.

(E) (1) ~~(1)~~ ~~(4)~~ THE SECRETARY ~~SHALL~~ MAY SECURE FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM FROM THE STATE BUDGET.

(2) FUNDING FOR THE PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED \$100,000 OF THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET.

(F) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, THE PROGRAM SHALL:

(1) ENCOURAGE ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS TO LEARN ENGLISH;
