(a) For the purpose of encouraging the location of new industries in Somerset County and for the purpose of encouraging the growth and development of factories, manufacturing industries, fabricating or assembling facilities, industrial plants, and the like in the County, the County Commissioners may exempt from County taxation factories, manufacturing industries, fabricating or assembling facilities, industrial plants, and the like, and the land, machinery, and tools [with] WHICH those facilities [used] USE, and stock in trade or products of [it] THE FACILITIES THAT ARE located in the County, as provided in this section.
