or

- (IV) CLUB;
- (V) DANCE STUDIO;
- (VI) DISCO; AND
- (VII) ANY OTHER PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT.
- [(2)](3) (i) The following are exempt from paragraph [(1)] (2) of this subsection:
 - 1. The room of a registered guest in a hotel, motel, or hospice;
 - 2. The property of a volunteer fire company.
- (ii) The following are exempt from paragraph [(1)] (2) of this subsection if they have been in existence for a minimum of 3 years:
 - 1. A bona fide catering establishment;
 - 2. A community or civic association;
 - 3. A swim club;
- 4. A bona fide social, civic, nonprofit, charitable, fraternal, patriotic, educational, or public service organization; [or]
 - 5. A bona fide religious institution; OR
- 6. <u>EXCEPT FOR NOTWITHSTANDING</u> THE 3-YEAR EXISTENCE <u>REQUIREMENT IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH</u>, A FISHING CLUB (NOTWITHSTANDING THE 3-YEAR EXISTENCE REQUIREMENT ABOVE) THAT WAS ESTABLISHED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1970.
- [(3)](4) The [Worcester County] Board of License Commissioners shall adopt uniform [rules] REGULATIONS for the administration of [exceptions specified in paragraph (2) of] THE PROVISIONS OF this subsection.
- [(4)](5) Any owner, operator, manager, or employee of premises or places subject to the prohibitions of this subsection who knowingly permits consumption in violation of this subsection is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be fined not more than \$10,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.
