

CHAPTER 249

(House Bill 340)

AN ACT concerning

**Wicomico County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Application for License)**

FOR the purpose of clarifying that, in Wicomico County, following the termination of a license, an applicant may submit a new application for a premise that was already in existence and for which a license was held within a certain number of months following the termination of the license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Wicomico County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

Section 9-223(d)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

9-223.

(d) A person may [reapply] APPLY for a license within 6 months following the termination of a license at an existing location that falls within the restrictions imposed by subsection (c) of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.
