

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 49B – Human Relations Commission

8A.

IT IS AN UNLAWFUL PRACTICE FOR AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTY, AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTY, OR PERSONS OR BUSINESSES LICENSED OR REGULATED BY THE STATE TO DISCRIMINATE AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL IN THE TERMS, CONDITIONS, OR PRIVILEGES OF THE LEASING OF PROPERTY FOR COMMERCIAL USAGE, OR IN THE PROVISION OF SERVICES OR FACILITIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE LEASING OF PROPERTY FOR COMMERCIAL USAGE, BECAUSE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, AGE, HANDICAP, MARITAL STATUS, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.
