(2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ANY UNEXPENDED MONEY AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE MARYLAND MILK COMMISSION FUND AND DOES NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

19 109.

- (A) ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSION MAY SEEK JUDICIAL REVIEW OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) THE COMMISSION'S REFUSAL TO ISSUE, REISSUE, SUSPEND, OR REVOKE A LICENSE:
- (2) A COMMISSION ORDER ESTABLISHING, REVISING, OR AMENDING THE PRICE OR TERMS UNDER WHICH MILK MAY BE BOUGHT OR SOLD ACCORDING TO THIS TITLE; AND
 - (3) A COMMISSION ORDER ESTABLISHING OR ABOLISHING A MARKET.
- (B) THE APPEAL SHALL BE MADE AS PROVIDED FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A FINAL DECISION IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

19-110.

- (A) THE COMMISSION MAY BRING AN ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION AGAINST A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE.
- (B) IN AN ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION UNDER THIS SECTION, ANY FINDING OF THE COMMISSION AFTER A HEARING IS PRIMA-FACIE EVIDENCE OF EACH FACT THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.
- (C) ON A SHOWING THAT A PERSON IS VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE; A COURT SHALL GRANT AN INJUNCTION WITHOUT REQUIRING A SHOWING OF A LACK OF AN ADEQUATE REMEDY AT LAW.
- (D) AN ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION UNDER THIS SECTION IS IN ADDITION TO, AND NOT INSTEAD OF, CRIMINAL PROSECUTION TAKEN UNDER § 19-111 OF THIS TITLE.

19-111.

- (A) (1) ANY PERSON-WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- (2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION OCCURS IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.
- (B) (1) THE STATE'S ATTORNEY OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH ANY VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE OCCURS SHALL PROSECUTE THE PERSON ACCUSED OF THE VIOLATION.
