FOR the purpose of altering the time during which a specimen of blood shall be taken to determine the drug or controlled dangerous substance content of a person's blood under certain circumstances; and generally relating to ehemical tests to determine drug or controlled dangerous substance content of a person's blood.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

10-303.

- (a) (1) A specimen of breath or 1 specimen of blood may be taken for the purpose of a test for determining alcohol concentration.
- (2) For the purpose of a test for determining alcohol concentration, the specimen of breath or blood shall be taken within 2 hours after the person accused is apprehended.
- (b) (1) Only 1 specimen of blood may be taken for the purpose of a test or tests for determining the drug or controlled dangerous substance content of the person's blood.
- (2) For the purpose of a test or tests for determining drug or controlled dangerous substance content of the person's blood, the specimen of blood shall be taken within [3] 4 hours after the person accused is apprehended.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.
