(a) (1) There is a Handgun Roster Board in the Department of [Public Safety and Correctional Services] STATE POLICE.

(3) The members of the Board shall be:

(i) The [Superintendent] SECRETARY;

(4) The [Superintendent] SECRETARY shall serve as Chairman of the Board.
