~~[(iv)] (V) Apply the provisions of THIS PARAGRAPH OR Parts 391 and 395 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations to a farmer, or an agent or employee of a farmer, who operates farm equipment or a motor vehicle owned or operated by the farmer in the transportation of supplies to a farm or the transportation of farm products as defined in § 10-601 of the Agriculture Article within 150 air miles of the farmer's farm;~~
